The Charles Kettaneh Foundation was established in 1987 to commemorate a man who was a great sponsor and a friend of the arts, and who cared about education. The managing committee is composed of Aimée Kettaneh the first president of Baalbeck International festivals, and her two children Naïla and Nabil. The foundation's main activities rotate around two axes: the education of the most deprived through donating annual funds to charity institutions, such as St Vincent of Paul, and others such as The American University of Beirut. The other axis is culture through supporting several projects and institutions among which are the AUB Museum, the National Museum, and the Lebanese Association for the Development of Cultural Funding.
